Chartered Financial Consultant (ChFC®)

The Chartered Financial Consultant ("ChFC®") is a financial planning designation for the insurance industry conferred by The American College. Candidates must meet education, experience, examination, and continuing ethical requirements. Candidates must have at least three years of experience in the financial industry, or an undergraduate or graduate degree from an accredited university and two years of experience in the financial industry. Candidates are required to take nine academic courses each followed by an exam. The courses and exams cover topics in finance, investing, insurance, and estate planning. The ChFC® requires 30 hours of continuing education every two years. Holders of the ChFC® designation must adhere to The American College's Code of Ethics.

Chartered Life Underwriter (CLU®)

The Chartered Life Underwriter (“CLU®”) is a designation of insurance expertise conferred by the American College. Candidates must meet education, experience, examination, and continuing ethical requirements. Candidates must have at least three years of full-time business experience in the financial industry and are required to take 8 academic courses each followed by an exam. The CLU® requires 30 hours of continuing education every two years. Holders of the CLU® designation must adhere to The American College’s Code of Ethics.

Accredited Asset Management Specialist (AAMS®)

The Accredited Asset Management Specialist (“AAMS®”), designation is conferred by the College of Financial Planning. Individuals who hold the AAMS® designation have completed a course of study encompassing investments, insurance, tax, retirement, and estate planning issues. Additionally, individuals must pass an end-of-course examination that tests their ability to synthesize complex concepts and apply theoretical concepts to real-life situations. All designees have agreed to adhere to Standards of Professional Conduct and are subject to a disciplinary process. Designees renew their designation every two-years by completing 16 hours of continuing education, reaffirming adherence to the Standards of Professional Conduct and complying with self-disclosure requirements

Accredited Domestic Partnership Advisor (ADPA®)

The Accredited Domestic Partnership Advisor, (“ADPA®”), designation is conferred by the College of Financial Planning. Individuals who hold the ADPA® designation have completed a course of study encompassing wealth transfers, federal taxation, retirement planning, and planning for financial and medical end-of-life needs for domestic partners. Additionally, individuals must pass an end-of-course examination that tests their ability to synthesize complex concepts and apply theoretical concepts to real-life situations. All designees have agreed to adhere to Standards of Professional Conduct and are subject to a disciplinary process. Designees renew their designation every two-years by completing 16 hours of continuing education, reaffirming adherence to the Standards of Professional Conduct and complying with self-disclosure requirements.

Retirement Income Certified Professional (RICP®)

The Retirement Income Certified Profession, (“RICP®”), designation is conferred by the American College. Individuals who hold the RICP® designation have completed a course of study encompassing building integrated and comprehensive retirement income plans. Additionally, three years of professional experience are required along with three required courses, equivalent of nine semester credit hours. Individuals must pass a final, closed book, proctored exam for each course. Designees renew their designation every two-years by completing 15 hours of continuing education, reaffirming adherence to the Standards of Professional Conduct and complying with self-disclosure requirements.
